

Dr. Michael Ruse Lucyle T. Werkmeister Professor, Florida State University

Michael Ruse is the Lucyle T. Werkmeister Professor of Philosophy and Director of the Program in the History and Philosophy of Science at Florida State University. He is the author or editor of over fifty books. Ruse has written extensively on the interface between science and religion and appeared as an expert witness in a case in Arkansas against the teaching of biblical literalism (Creationism) in state-supported science classes. He has co-edited the Oxford Handbook of Atheism. His next book, The Problem of War, compares Christians and Darwinians on the topic of human conflict.
